To be eligible for this grant your program must meet two criteria:



Be Level 2 in Colorado Shines

How long does it take to become a Level 2?

It depends on the size of your program. The most time-consuming part of becoming a Level 2 depends on how many staff you have. Some programs do it in a week, others several weeks.

Does becoming a Level 2 require a Licensing visit?

No. You can do it all from your computer.

What are the perks of being Level 2?

You can use your Level 2 as advertising for your program and to appeal to grant-makers (who now require at least a Level 2). Also, the higher level you are, the higher CCAP reimbursement rate you receive.

How do I become a Level 2?

Hold a CCAP Contract with La Plata County

Do I need to have a CCAP child in my program?

No. You only need to have signed a CCAP contract with the La Plata Department of Human Services, which simply enables you to accept a child with CCAP at any point in the future, if you choose.

Does a CCAP contract require a Licensing visit? No.

What are the perks of having a CCAP contract?

You can accept families who qualify for CCAP and get reimbursed at a fixed rate from the county; and of course, apply for this State money.

How much do I get paid for a child with CCAP? See this reimbursement scale.


How do I get a CCAP contract?

How to Apply

- 1. Log into your QRIS profile here (now called "Provider Hub"): https://coloradoshinesportal.force.com/providerhub/s/login/
- 2. Click on the "Quality Improvement" tab and then "QIP Funds". This tab takes a long time to load but eventually will show the ECCLPC logo and a grant description.
- 3. Click "Start A New Application" and enter your information into each section, saving as you go. See your progress by the color of the dots in the left side bar.
- 4. Once you've completed all the sections click on "Application Summary" in the left side bar and apply!
- 5. You will receive an email with your grant award amount and the MOU. Sign the MOU electronically and your money will be available within a few days. You will get an additional email from ECCLPC with directions on how to spend your money.
