



Privacy Policy

The Early Childhood Council of La Plata County (ECCLPC) is a non-profit organization. ECCLPC is committed to respecting the privacy and security of your personal information. The following online Privacy Policy (dated 12/10/19) describes the following:

- What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the website, how it is used, and with whom it may be shared.
- The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
- Modifications to this Privacy Policy.
- By using this website, you consent to our Privacy Policy. For questions, concerns or the modification or removal of personal information, please contact us.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to/collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13.

We gather information about how visitors use our website. Users can visit our website without revealing any information about themselves. We may track your visits for trends, insights and statistics, but you will remain anonymous unless you actively submit your personal data to us. If one chooses to give us personal information, then it is our intent to let you know how we will use such information.

We may disclose aggregate statistics regarding donations to third parties, but these statistics do not include any personally identifiable information. We will not share your personally identifiable information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the ECCLPC website, your information is protected both online and offline. To protect your information, we use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) encryption technology.

Whenever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. Our online credit card verification system is handled by a third party, which collects your name, address, phone, credit card number, and expiration date to process your transaction. Their encryption technology offers a high level of security to ensure confidentiality of your transaction.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, billing) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Modifications

We may amend this privacy policy from time to time; please review it periodically. We maintain the option to modify this privacy at any time by electronic notice posted on our website. Your continued use of our website after the date that such notices are posted will be deemed to be your agreement to the changed terms.
