

EARLY CHILDHOOD TEACHER QUALIFICATION PATHWAY CHART

An Early Childhood Teacher, assigned responsibility for a single group of children and working under the supervision of a Director, must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and meet at least one (1) of the following qualifications:

- All International Official Transcripts awarded outside of the United States must be evaluated for United States
 equivalency. The Department accepts evaluations from organizations approved by The National Association of
 Credential Evaluation Services (NACES). www.naces.org/members. Unfortunately, international experience is not
 accepted by the Department.
- As of 06/14/2021 the Early Childhood Professional Credential (ECPC) Version 3.0 system has gone into effect. Individuals can meet Early Childhood Teacher Qualifications based on their ECPC version 3.0 Level II (2). Individuals that have an ECPC Version 2.0 may use their Credential Level III (3) until expiration.
